## **RHDV Carcass Disposal Guidance**

## **Carcass Handling**

If you experience a mortality event in your colony or if you find a dead wild rabbit:

- Wear gloves when handling deceased rabbits.
- Double bag carcass and spray the outside of the bag with disinfectant.
- Contact your State Veterinarian if domestic rabbit or your State Department of Fish and Wildlife if a wild rabbit to determine if testing should be done.
- If testing required, refrigerate bagged carcass or pack in ice.
- Wash your hands after handling.
- Follow shipping or collection guidance from your state veterinarian.
- Do not freeze carcass for human or animal consumption.

## **Disposal Options**

If testing is not required, the carcass should be disposed of in compliance with your county regulations and local Department of Health. Disposal options include:

- Incineration
- Double bag and burial at least 3 feet deep.
- Double bag and landfill
